### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS:**

Authors are invited to submit full papers (12-15 pages long) or one-page descriptions of panel proposals by February 28, 2005 through the conference web site at <a href="http://aria.asu.edu/mis2005">http://aria.asu.edu/mis2005</a>. Papers must be in PDF and formatted according to LNCS rules (<a href="http://www.springer.de/comp/lncs/authors.html">http://www.springer.de/comp/lncs/authors.html</a>). Each paper or panel proposal should have an extra cover page with name, title, and address (including e-mail address) of the contact author and an abstract of no more than 200 words. Each panel proposal should also include a list of proposed panelists. Papers will be selected for publication based on originality and contribution to the field.

### **JOURNAL SPECIAL ISSUE:**

Selected papers will be chosen to be submitted, for further review, as full papers to a special issue on "the use of context in multimedia information systems" of the ACM Transactions on Multimedia Computing, Communications, and Applications. (ACM TOMCCAP) journal.
