The Conference on Networked Systems (NetSys 2013) provides an international forum for engineers and scientists in academia, industry, and government to discuss innovations in the realm of networked systems – including aspects of networking, distributed systems, communications, middleware, and applications. This biennial conference is the major scientific event on networked systems in German-speaking countries and belongs to a series of conferences (Kommunikation in Verteilten Systemen – KiVS) that was founded more than 30 years ago. Presented papers will be archived in IEEE Xplore® (pending).

For NetSys 2013 we especially encourage the submission of papers focusing on the techniques and applications of virtualization in networked systems.
